



Silent Workings

Artist Sophia Douma, who studied at the Athens Fine Arts School under George Mavroides, Yannis Moralis and Dimitris Mytaras will exhibit a series of paintings and sculptures from her mature period (1992-2000) and her adolescent years (1955-1957). Early drafts of many of the artist's projects are to be found in her diaries that go back to her teenage years.
