

Participants in ACS Athens's 5th Annual Conference on Learning Differences, 2010 have the opportunity *to obtain (3) three semester graduate credits* from the University of Indianapolis, Athens (Uindy, Athens). The cost is 85 Euros per credit (for non-Uindy students), for a total cost of 255 Euros. The course will be identified as: PSY580 as described below:

PSY580: Learning Differences: Teaching/Counseling Children [3 credits] ... [if undergraduate GPA>3.0/4.0 or 6.5/10]

Participants can apply and register on the day of the conference and send the rest of the records for their file via mail. A complete file is required for credit transcript issuance.

Requirements for a complete file are:

1. Completed registration and application forms.
2. Official transcript verifying the receipt of your undergraduate degree.
3. 3 letters of recommendation

To obtain *three* graduate credits, individuals must:

- Attend all of the sessions of the workshop.
- Participate in the workshop activities and complete assignments as directed by the workshop instructor(s).
- Complete a paper (10-12) pages, Space: 1.5, Font: Times New Roman, Size: 12, that explains possible applications from the different workshops attended, to your teaching and/or administrative responsibilities.
