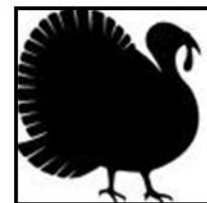

TUES. NOV. 8!**

Ted Lelekas' Seminar on Wine Appreciation has been running since 2007. It is aimed at novice, amateur oenophiles who would like to gain knowledge and practical experience on wine, in order to become informed consumers.

The Seminar is based on 8 weekly sessions that cover everything that the amateur wine-lover needs to get started. Each session lasts roughly 2 hours and comprises a theoretical part (a presentation by Ted) and a tutored tasting of relevant wines.

The Seminar will take place at the private alcove of Abovo restaurant in Kefalari (37 Kolokotroni Street, Kefalari Square), one of the hottest new arrivals in the Athens restaurant scene this season. The cost of participation in the seminar is €250, inclusive of all wines tasted. The seminar will be conducted in English.

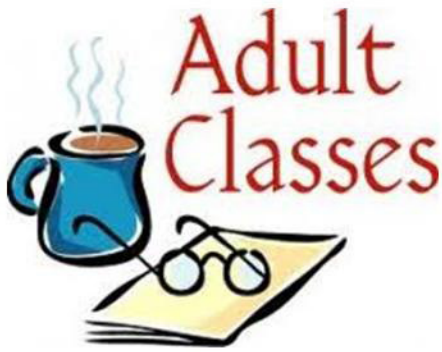
